ERS Board of Control Election Begins Today

- The following positions are currently up for election: State Employee, No. 1; Local Employee, No. 1; and Retired State Employee. The State and Local Employee positions have a four-year term, while the Retired State Employee position has a three-year term. All terms begin October 1, 2018. State Employee, No. 1, is currently held by Steve Walkley; Local Employee, No. 1, by Steve Williams; and Retired State Employee by Jimmy Rowell.
- There are three ways to vote:
 - ◊ Online: At <u>rsavotes.com</u>
 - By mail: Anyone who is eligible to vote in this election will receive a paper ballot by mail. Please allow 7 to 10 business days to receive your ballot.
 - By telephone: Each position has a unique telephone number that will be provided on the paper ballot.
- For each method, you must have your Election Code and Voting PIN, which are included on the paper ballot.
- If your preferred method of communication from the RSA is email, you will receive an email ballot that includes your Election Code and Voting PIN.
